Uniform Rules


*Come in proper school uniform (Grey colour) on all days till June. The school has discontinued white uniform and introduced new Sports Uniform which consists of sports T-shirt (in House colour with the school logo), sports track pant and sports shoes (Black) from August.

*Students must wear identity card with the latest photograph fixed on it.

*Nails should be clipped short and clean.

*Short, neat haircut for boys with no fancy cuts and girls are permitted to wear small earrings.





Attendance

- *Students must attend the class regularly.
- *No leave is granted except for valid reasons and only on prior application/ mail by the parents to the class teacher.
- *In case of medical leave, submit medical certificates.
- *In case of absence for a day without prior information, submit leave letter.
- *Students should attend all tests and exams.
- *Tests, examinations and SEAs will not be reconducted for the absentee students.
- *Ensure that activities & assignments given at regular intervals are completed and submitted in time.
- *As per the CBSE Board norms, 75% of attendance is mandatory for the promotion to the next class.



Time Table

*Students should strictly follow the given time table.

*Students must bring the text book/ note book /activity book etc. as per the instructions given by the subject teacher.

Tips to Pack School Bag

- *Take only the books that are required at school. Some subjects might have more than two books, and you must be aware of what book is meant for that day.
- *Organizing books daily helps to take out the books that will not be used for the day and help reduce the bag weight.
- *Avoid packing unnecessary things just because the bag can hold them.
- *Place the heavier books closer to your back. This way, the weight will not be focused on the shoulders.
- *Make use of the various compartments to put in books, notebooks, stationery and lunch boxes. This will not only help you find things easily, but also distribute the weight more evenly.

*Mobiles, smart watches and other electronic gadgets are strictly not allowed.



Library Rules

- * Strict silence must be maintained in the library.
- * Library period is strictly meant for reading books.
- * No one can take a book from the library without having it duly entered.
- * A student may borrow maximum of one book at a time.
- * A book is issued for a period of 7 days starting from the date of issue. The book must be returned on the due date. If the due date happens to be a holiday the book must be returned on the next working day.
- * Books can be re-issued once again if no one else requires it.
- * Reference books, reserved books, new arrivals and periodicals will not be issued to anybody and shall not be taken out of the library.
- * Personal books, bags and belongings are not supposed to be brought into the library.
- * In case a reader loses a book he/she should replace the book. In case the book cannot be replaced; the current price of the book will be paid by the borrower.

First Aid Room

- School provides first aid facility to the students and staff members.
- Students can visit First Aid room located in block A ground floor.
- Students should take permission from the class teacher to visit the first aid room. They should go with proper out pass.
- Do not take a classmate for help and support if not required.
- Any student feeling unwell should be sent to the medical room. If the nurse is not in the medical room, proceed to the reception.
- If a child is found to be very sick, he/she will be sent home.
- For any emergency, children will be sent to the hospital and parents will be informed.

ENSURE TRANSPORT SAFETY

- 1.Get to the bus stop at least five minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive.
- 2. When the bus approaches, stand at least 6 feet away.
- 3. Wait until the bus stops and the door opens.
 - 4. If you have to cross the street in front of the bus, walk on the sidewalk.
 - 5. Never walk behind the bus.
 - 6. Take the assigned seat.
 - 7. Do not make noise. The driver may be distracted.
 - 8. The child should be dropped and picked on time.
- 9. For any reason, if the transport is delayed, ask your ward to come and wait in the school lobby (reception area) Block D.

- *Children are not allowed to elaborately celebrate their birthdays in the school.

- *Students are advised to engage in responsible behaviour in cyberspace.

- *Parents/guardians should monitor their ward's social media activities.
- *Parents can plan on NO SCREEN TIME on some particular day/time for children.

Parental Controls to Ensure Cyber safety

*Internet filters

Install Internet filters on your child's devices to block access to inappropriate websites and content.

*Privacy settings

Teach your child to use privacy settings on social media platforms and other websites to limit who can see their information and posts.

*Time limits

Set time limits for your child's online activities to ensure they are not spending excessive time on their devices.

*Safe search

Enable safe search on search engines like Google to ensure that your child is not accidentally exposed to inappropriate content.

*Parental control software

Install parental control software on your child's devices to monitor and control their online activity.



- * Have open communication with your child about their online activity and teach them about the risks associated with cyberspace.
- * Be careful of what to download.
- * Some programs and apps carry malware and try to steal information. Teach children to download content from trusted sites only.
- * Monitor online activities keep an eye on your child's online activities, including the websites they visit and the apps they use.
- * Educate your child about online safety.
- * Teach your child about safe online behaviour.
- * Be a good role model.
- *Set an example for your child by practicing safe online behaviour you use yourself. Avoid using devices during family time and show your child how you use technology responsibly.

- *WhatsApp groups are created for the new session, it is mandatory to join the group with active mobile numbers to receive updates from the school.
