

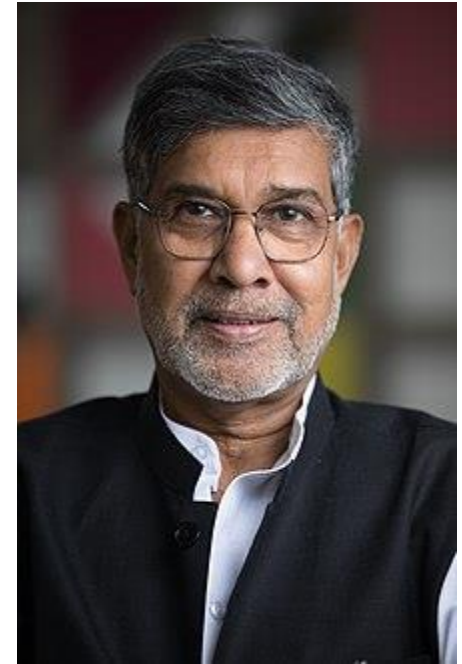
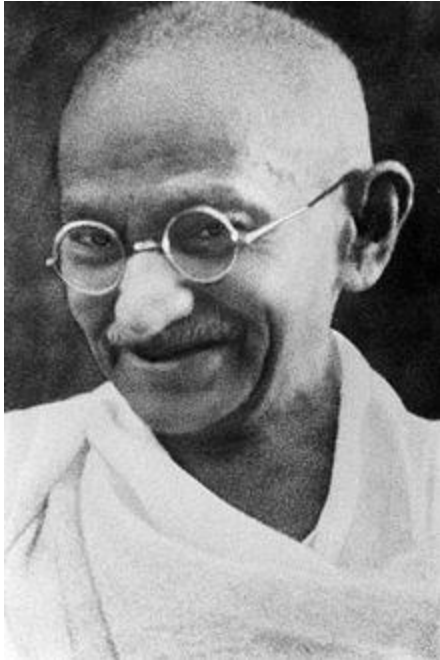

Make students understand themselves in relation to their community.

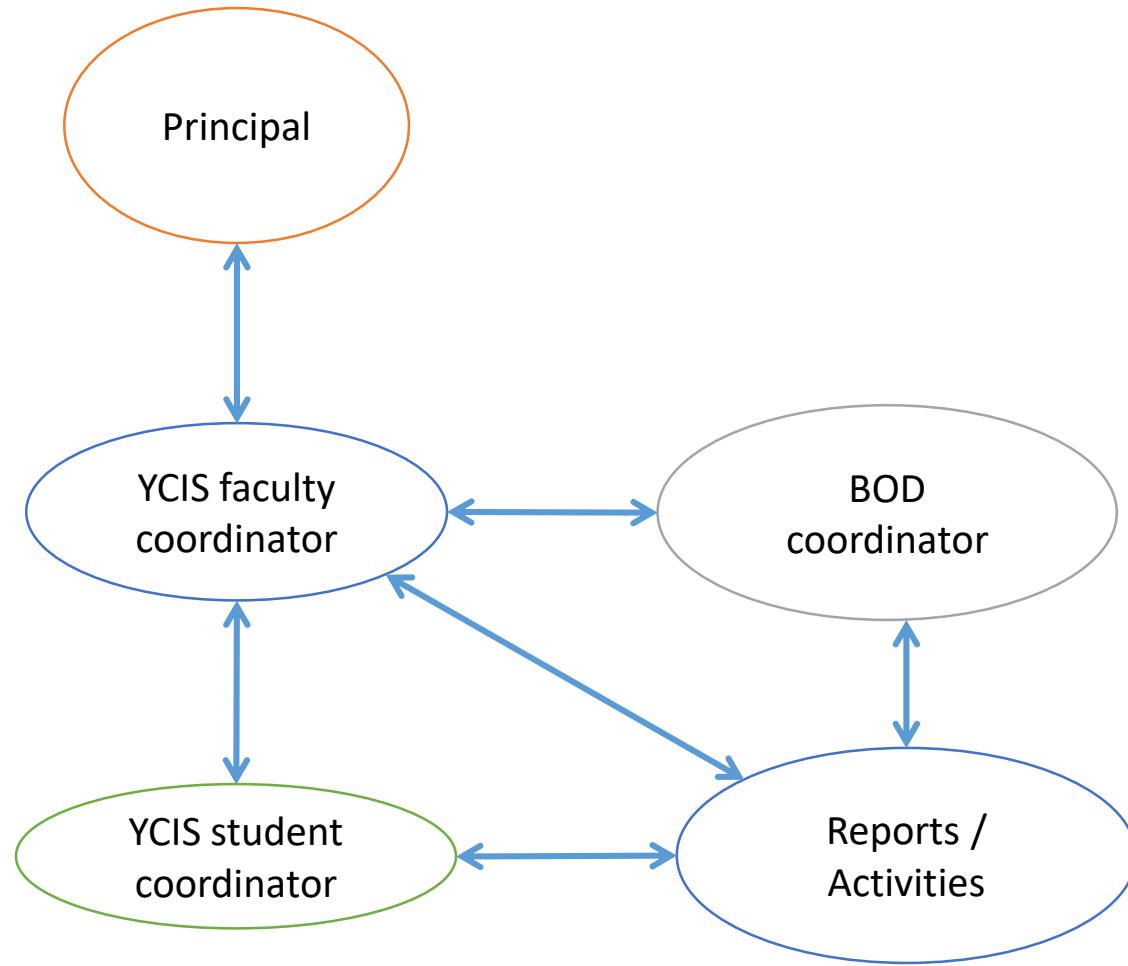
Develop passion for selfless service among students.

YCIS FRAMEWORK



Working Model



YCID is of three folds.

1. The volunteer is expected to contribute to the **development of community.**
2. The volunteer should serve the **poor and needy section of the society.**
3. There should be a contribution towards **preserving the environment.**

In each of these fields, the student is expected to spend **20 hrs each** so as to be eligible for this award over a period of **minimum 1 year and maximum 2 years.**

Some of the activities.....



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

- Organizing short-term workshops for blue collared expatriates
- Organize Entertainment programs at labor camps.
- Organize a Community Blood Donation Drive
- Organize development programs for families of blue collared employees
- Read and write letters on behalf of illiterate expatriates.
- Read out books or letters to a person who is visually challenged.
- Organize summer reading programs to encourage kids to read

Some of the activities.....



Assisting the needy

- Spend qualitative time with terminally ill people in hospitals.
- Identify downtrodden people in the locality and address their needs.
- Raise charity funds for the benefit of downtrodden people in the locality.
- Organize charity functions to raise funds for specific causes
- Efforts towards providing food, clothes and shelter to the needy.
- Organize events to promote inclusion of physically, mentally disabled children and adults.
- Organise donation drives

Some of the activities.....

Preserving the environment

- Cleaning programs at the school premises.
- Clearing the debris in beaches (if available).
- Organizing environmental related awareness programs for community/ school mates. Eg: Recycling contests
- Organizing rallies to create awareness among general public about the need for preserving environment.

YCIS IMPLEMENTATION



- Expression of Interest by volunteer students countersigned by Parent / Guardian.
- Developing community service plans by students, duly approved by faculty coordinator
- No funding by schools. It has to be done by faculty and student together.
- Projects to be of non-hazardous nature and occur outside of the school day/hours.
- Projects of political, religious and all other controversial subjects – NO
- No student shall receive or take monetary compensation for the services rendered.
- Certification by Faculty coordinator for all project related activities.
- Periodic report to BoD.
