**MATHS**

- Numbers up to 10,000.
- Addition of 4 digit numbers (with & without regrouping).
- Subtraction of 4 digit numbers (with & without regrouping).
- Multiplication of 2 & 3 digit numbers (with & without regrouping).
- Division of 2 & 3 digit numbers by 1 – digit number.
- Fraction ( $\frac{1}{4}$  ,  $\frac{1}{2}$  ,  $\frac{3}{4}$  ) – shading, to find fraction of number, numerator and denominator.
- Geometry (plane shapes and solid shapes).
- Measurement (conversion between different units of length, use of appropriate units).
- Time (time reading, quarter past, half past).

**ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE (EVS)**

- Living and Non-Living Things - Features and definitions.
- Plant Life - Parts of a plant and its functions, photosynthesis process, types of plants - herbs, shrubs, trees, climbers, creepers and uses of plants, leaf structure, flower, fruits and germination.
- Animal Life - Types of animals- herbivores, omnivores, carnivores and scavengers, types of animals shelter, animal body parts and their functions, birds - body parts and their function, different types of nests, beaks and claws, food chain, birds movement (upstroke and downstroke and three types of feathers)
- Organ System - External and internal organs of a human body -heart, lungs, brain, stomach, liver, kidneys, digestion process, breathing system, circulatory system, nervous system, excretory system, reproductive system, sense organs and their functions.
- Air, Water and Weather – Water and its forms, change of state, water cycle, sources of water, sunny, windy, cloudy, rainy days and seasons.
- Light, Sound and Force - Luminous and Non-Luminous objects, shadow and its formation, sound, noise, force and friction.
- Heavenly Bodies – Planets, moon, satellite, phases of moon, star, constellations, shape of earth, rotation and revolution, formation of day and night.
