After school she went on to study Political Science at the Government College for Women, Amritsar.

Kiran excelled in sports, particularly Tennis. She won the Inter-University women’s team title and bagged the National as well as the Asian Title in Tennis. Bedi says the game taught her the value of hard work, the importance of staying fit and built in her the qualities of fair play, team work, concentration, and ability to give in that extra bit under stress.

Kiran Bedi was selected for Indian Police Service in 1972 and was the first woman police officer of Indian Police Service. Spectators at the 1973 Republic Day Parade were amazed to see a lady at the head of the Police Contingent.
