

We lived in our ancestral house, which was built in the middle of the 19<sup>th</sup> century. It was a fairly large pucca house, made of limestone and brick, on the mosque street of Rameswaram. My austere fatherused to avoid all inessential comforts and luxuries. However all that was needed was provided for, in terms of food, medicine or clothes. In fact, I would say mine was a very secure childhood, both materially and emotionally'.
