The beans turn into a rich colour and begin to smell like chocolate after being left in a damp place for a few days. They are roasted and grounded into a paste, in a factory. A fatty yellow liquid 'cocoa butter' has to be removed from the paste to make dry cocoa powder. The paste infact is very bitter. So, a lot of sugar is mixed in it. The chocolate is then poured into moulds to harden into chocolate bars.
