Jupiter, the fifth planet from the sun, is the largest planet in the solar system. It is the first of the “gas giants” and has no surface, though it may have a rocky core. Although it is only 1/1000th as massive as the sun, it is more than twice as massive as all of the other planets in the solar system combined. Jupiter’s most notable feature, other than its size, is the great red spot, a football shaped area of intense storms. The spot, which is a high pressure, stable storm with winds, is said to be somewhat similar to a hurricane. In addition, Jupiter also has a faint set of rings (probably made of dust) that wrap around the planet horizontally. Jupiter has at least 63 moons, more than any other planet. The four Galilean moons of Jupiter are the most massive. Galileo discovered these moons in 1610. They were first moons discovered of any planet other than Earth’s.
