After 1940, things were not so good anymore. First the war started and then the Germans arrived in Holland. Our freedom disappeared. Under the new German laws, Jews must wear a yellow star. They can only do their shopping in ‘Jewish Shops’ and they must be indoors by eight o’ clock at night. They must not even sit in their own gardens after that time. Jews cannot visit theatre or the cinema. Jews cannot visit Christians, and their children must go to Jewish schools.

On Sunday afternoon we heard that the German were going to take father away. We know what that means- to a concentration camp. ‘Mother has gone to ask Mr. Van Daan about our hiding-place’, said Margot. Mr. Van Daan worked in the business with Daddy and he is a good friend of his. The hiding-place is in father’s Office building.
