- The email must also include the student's name, class, section and a passportsized photograph
- Cover pages which depict pertinent happenings (like online education) through Indian folk art (like Madhubani, Patachitra, Warli, Gond, etc) will be favoured.

The entries should be submitted in the following languages only: **English, Hindi, Malayalam, Sanskrit and Arabic.**

Rules:

1. Acceptable entries include:

- Articles (150 words max.)
- Short stories (250 words max.)
- Poems (80words max.)
- Essays (250 words max.)
- Travelogues (200 words max.)
- Plays (200 words max.)
- Letters from Students (Inspirational messages for the students, personal achievements to inspire fellow students, etcetera in 200 words)
- Puzzles, riddles, comics, infographics and humour
- Photography and Art

Possible themes and ideas include:

- Reviews and recommendations for books, music and art
- Profiles of lesser-known luminaries and role-models
- Founding and history of our school
- Interesting news on relevant issues
- Opinion articles, for example, ideal society, perfect teacher, etcetera
- Self-help articles, for example, How I make friends, How I cope with loss, etcetera
- Personal experiences
- Unique and original recipes

The last date for submission of entries is on or before **5th December 2020**.

- 2. The written compositions must be mailed from the student's official school email ID, as documents in <u>editable word format</u>. Artworks should be <u>scanned</u> and mailed. Please refer to the presentation for further clarity.
- 3. The font for all compositions should be 'Times New Roman', with the <u>headings in Size</u> <u>16</u>, <u>content in Size 14</u> and <u>1.0 line spacing</u>.
- 4. The content should be secular, apolitical and inoffensive.
- 5. The content must be original. Plagiarism will not be entertained, and strict action will be taken against offenders.
- 6. Students must include their name, class and section in their <u>email and attached document</u>. Students must also include a passport-sized photograph with a blue background in their email.
- 7. Late entries, hard copies as well as entries not adhering to the word limit and format will not be accepted.
