RULES

Acceptable entries include-

- 1. Articles (150 words max.)
- 2. Short stories (200 words max.)
- 3. Poems (80 words max.)
- 4. Essays (250-300 words)
- 5. Travelogues (150 words max.)
- 6. Reviews and recommendations for books, music and art (100 words max.)
- 7. Recipes, DIY and Crafts (80-100 words max.)
- 8. Puzzles, riddles, comics, infographics. (80 words max.)
- 9. Letters from Students (Inspirational messages for the students, personal achievements to inspire fellow students, etcetera in 200 words)
- 10. Paintings, sketches, Photography and other Art forms.
- 11. Profiles of lesser-known luminaries and role-models like Savitribai Phule, Vishwa Mohan Bhatt etc. (80 words max.)
- 12. Interesting news on relevant issues (100 words max.)
- 13. Memes

Possible ideas/themes include:

- 1. Opinion articles, for example, ideal society, perfect students etc.
- 2. Self-help articles, Mental well-being, Stress Management
- 3. Personal experiences
- 4. The Future of Education
- 5. Career Guidance and Financial Literacy
- 6. Social Issues and Advocacy

The last date of submission will be Friday, 2nd of August, 2024.

- The written compositions must be mailed from the student's official school email ID, as documents.
- Artworks should be scanned and mailed. Ensure that the scanned images are of good clarity.
- Students can send as many memes as they want. They can be either in English, or in Hindi.
- The font for all compositions should be 'Times New Roman', with the headings in Size 16, content in Size 14 and 1.0 line spacing.
- The content should be secular, apolitical and inoffensive.
