PT III (IX & X) and UT III (XI & XII) examination will be conducted in online mode. Being our partners in online classes, we request the parents to supervise and invigilate tests, on behalf of ISS to ensure its smooth conduction.

Regular class will be held in the hybrid mode/ online mode as per the schedule given in the circular released on 19.01.2022.

- Question Paper will be in the form of an assignment.
- Question Paper pattern : Descriptive, as per the latest CBSE sample paper.

 - 05:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. (Including Writing time 40 Min., Uploading time 20 Min.) Release of Q. Paper :- 4:50 p.m.
- Question paper will be mailed to your ward's registered Email address.
- Separate examination link will be sent by the subject teacher, one day before the date of the examination. Students must join the Google Meet link and attempt the examination.
- **Examination** will be proctored and invigilated by the subject teacher. Please ensure that camera is in **ON position throughout the examination.**
- Students would be required to keep the following items ready before writing the examination:-
 - A4 size ruled papers.
 - All the stationery items like pen, pencil, eraser, scale, geometry tools
 - Stapler or thread to tie all the answer sheets
 - Students must write all the answers neatly in the answer sheet.
- On the top-right side of each page, write page number in a circle.
- Use blue / black pen for writing the examination.
- All original sheets, subject wise should be kept in a folder at home, subject to submission, as informed by the school.
- ❖ **Submission Procedure**:- At the end of the examination, the paper should be scanned and uploaded in the form of PDF.(In the respective Google Classrooms)
