- 3. Registration form will be sent to all the students through Google forms. Interested students can fill the form and submit **on or before Sunday, 6**th **September 2020**.

QUIZ RULES

- 1. Indian School Sohar will use **Google forms** for conducting the quiz. **The question paper will be** sent through the registered Email ID 10 minutes prior to the stipulated time.
- 2. Quiz will comprise 20 questions of general nature (20 MCQs) to be attempted in 20 minutes. The link will be kept active only for the prescribed time.
- 3. Five questions will be given as tie breaker questions (in the same paper), in case of a tie the score of these questions will be used.
- 4. Two winners will be selected.

SCHEDULE, RULES AND REGULATIONS JUNIOR & SENIOR CATEGORY

1 First Prelims

- All valid registered individuals can attempt the first round on Thursday, 1st October 2020 at 10:00 am (Junior Category) and 11:00 am (Senior Category).
- 1.2 All details on the start page of the Quiz must be entered correctly, without any errors.
- 1.3 The link for the quiz will be active for 20 minutes from the start of the quiz.
- 1.4 All the students who have scored the benchmark decided by the host school will be qualified for the Second Prelims.
- 1.5 15 questions to be answered within 7 minutes.

2 Second Prelims

- 2.1 The host school website will publish the list of selected students for the Second Prelims.
- The second prelims will be conducted online on Tuesday, 6th October 2020 at 10:00 am (Junior category) and 11:00 am (Senior Category).
- 2.3 The quiz link and the password will be sent to the coordinators 10 minutes before the commencement of the Quiz.
- 2.4 Students who clear the benchmark score decided by the host school will be qualified for the Mega Prelims.
- 2.5 The list of students qualified for the Mega Prelims will be published on the host school's website.
- 2.6 25 questions to be answered within 10 minutes.

QUIZ RULES

THE BREAKERS – FOR FIRST TWO ROUNDS

There will be breakers to decide the set number of participants to the next stage at all stages of the contest and in case of a Tie.

Tie Breaker Criteria in order -

- 1. Answering Predetermined Tie Breaker Questions Correctly.
- 2. Shortest Time taken for Completion.

3 **Mega Prelims**

- Mega Prelims will be conducted on Thursday, 8th October 2020. 3.1
- 3.2 The selected students will receive the zoom link and password 30 minutes prior to the Quiz.
- 3.3 The online Quiz will be conducted by the Quiz master and questions will be made available to the students during the time of the event.
- 3.4 Top 8 from each category will be selected and the results will be displayed in the host school's website.

4 **Grand Finale**

- Grand Finale will be conducted on Saturday, 10th October 2020 on Zoom. 4.1
- 4.2 The Quiz master will conduct the Quiz, the meeting id and password will be sent to the participants 20 minutes prior to the event.
- 4.3 The event will go live on You Tube & Face Book
- 4.4 The participants should be ready with their mobile during the event as it will be considered as a buzzer.
