Dear Students,

Greetings!

Indian School Sohar is pleased to announce that we will be organizing the **Inter-House English Debate Competition - 2023** on Thursday, 1st June, 2023 for **STD. IX – XII** during school hours.

We would like to invite all the students from Std. IX to XII to participate in this prestigious event and make it successful.

General Instructions:

- 1) Students must enroll as a team one proposing the motion and the other opposing the motion.
- 2) The motion for the debate will be given only two hours before the competition. The topic will be suggested to the participants on the day of the competition.
- 3) The order of presentation will be decided by drawing lots.
- 4) The teams will be seated in Block 'C', Computer Lab to prepare their speeches without the assistance of the teachers.
- 5) The time limit for each speaker is 3 minutes. A warning bell will be sounded at 2 ½ minutes and a final bell at 3 minutes. Anything spoken after the final bell will not be marked for evaluation. At the end of the speech (4 For and 4 Against), the rebuttal speech will commence in the same order.
- 6) The rebuttal will be limited to two questions per team. Each team member may ask not more than one question. Members of the same team are not permitted to question each other. Questions should be specific and based on the speech.
- Display of charts or written documents is not allowed while speaking. Reading out from a prepared script will not be allowed.
- 8) Controversial statements detrimental to any individual, religion, country and political statements should be avoided.
- 9) The use of mobile phones and smart watches is not permitted during the event.
- 10) The speakers in a team can be from any class. (IX XII)
- 11) Interested students must contact their respective House Masters by 25th May, 2023.
- 12) The selection must be done by 30th May, 2023 and selected 2 pairs of each house will participate in the Inter-House Debate Competition, which will be held on 1st June, 2023.
- 13) The winners will participate in the 'Ambassador's Polemic Challenge 2023', to be held in August, 2023.

Certificates will be awarded in the following categories:

- a) Best Speaker
- b) First Runner-up
- c) Second Runner-up
- d) Best Rebuttal
