- 1. Be at the bus stop 5 minutes prior to the arrival of the bus / transport. Never run to or from the bus.
- 2. Stand 6 feet (or three giant steps) away from the curb while waiting for the bus.
- 3. Take your seat promptly and sit properly, facing forward at all times.
- 4. Throwing objects inside or outside of the bus is not permitted.
- 5. Talk quietly; the driver needs to concentrate to safely drive the bus. Fighting, shouting, or use of obscene language is not permitted.
- 6. Remain in the seat until the bus comes to a complete stop.
- 7. Never try to pick up something you dropped near the bus by yourself.
- 8. Do not sleep in the bus.
- 9. Help younger ones to alight from the bus.

## 10. STAY OUT OF THE DANGER ZONE:

The area around a school bus is called the Danger Zone.

The students are supposed to stay out of this zone.
